To Whom It May Concern:

I am pleased to write this letter of reference on behalf of Roofing Concepts Unlimited (RCU).

Wynmoor Village is a senior community located in North Central Broward County, consisting of 5,260 units in 144 buildings. On October 24, 2005, we were included in the devastation inflicted by Hurricane Wilma. Approximately 90 buildings suffered roof damage ranging from minor to severe. Some buildings had gaping holes, while others were so badly damaged water was, literally, pouring in on residents. We had no power and communication was minimal. Needless to say, our situation was overwhelming.

I was able to contact Michael Jacobozzi, principal of RCU (he was in Chicago at the time). Mr. Jacobozzi promised his cooperation and met with my staff and supervisory personnel the following day! We developed a plan of action and RCU's qualified staff immediately went to work doing emergency repairs to secure the property using safe and reliable methods at all times. The City of Coconut Creek's Building Department was notified that, at a time when virtually no help was available, RCU exclusively offered us assistance. The City encouraged us to move forward as quickly as possible.

As of this writing, RCU has successfully completed a total of 80 buildings, both tile and flat roofs in a period of less than one year.
